



## Football field

- The football field is 120 yards long x 60 yards wide.
- The playing field is 100 yards long, and each end zone is 10 yards deep in which players score.
- The field is marked with a yard line every 5 yards, and every 10 yards is marked by a field number.

## Goalposts

- The crossbar of goalpost is 10 feet high, and the vertical posts add additional 20 feet high, for a total of 30 feet high.
- The distance between vertical two goal posts is 18.5 feet wide.

## Number of players in field

- In American football, each team has a total of 11 players on the field at one time. Teams are allowed unlimited substitutions.
- Three teams of players: the offense team (the team with the ball, which is trying to score), the defense team (the team trying to prevent the

other team from scoring, and to take the ball from them), and the special team (who play in kicking situations).

## **Officials**

- During professional football game, seven officials or referees operate on the field.

## **Time of Play**

- The professional football games are 60 minutes long, divided into four quarters of 15 minutes each, separated by a 12 minutes break at half-time.
- The referee controls the game clock and stops the clock after any incomplete pass or any play that ends out of bounds.
- Each team is allowed 3 timeouts (30 seconds in length) in each half of the game.
- A two-minute warning is given when two minutes of game time remain on the game clock in each half of a game or overtime.

## **Seating**

- MetLife Stadium in East Rutherford, New Jersey has the highest listed seating capacity at 82,500.
- With a peak capacity of over 100,000 spectators and 3 million total square footage, AT&T Stadium has the highest capacity of any NFL stadium.

- AT&T stadium, is a retractable roof stadium in Arlington, Texas. It serves as the home of the Dallas Cowboys of the National Football League and was completed on May 27, 2009.

### **Most Championships in Super Bowl History**

- The New England Patriots and Pittsburgh Steelers have won the most Super Bowls with six championships.
- Dallas Cowboys and the San Francisco 49ers have five wins.
